Dear Judit,

thank you very much for accepting to come and making constructive criticism of the Danish tradition in popular enlightenment and adult education, at the conference at the Nordic Folk Academy 7-8 December 1992 organized by The Steering Committee on General and Adult Education in the Nordic Council of Ministers. The title of the conference is "Adult education in the future - a challenge for the Nordic Countries", and the title for your contribution is "Europe challenges Nordic popular enlightenment"
